

In Honor of Your 500th Anniversary...

It's only your 499th, the big 500th is a year away, but we're starting the celebration now. Lutherans, in particular, have a reason to remember the beginning of the Reformation on October 31, 1517, as the day Martin Luther nailed his 95 Theses on the door of the Wittenberg Church, starting a debate about indulgences. That debate led to discussions about grace, and faith, and scripture that have influenced Christianity ever since.

An ecumenical service of Evening Prayer on Thursday, Oct. 27th will kick off an entire year of remembering the Reformation. Christ the King Lutheran Church (1001 W. Esplanade Ave., Kenner) will host this worship opportunity for Lutherans to worship with Catholics and other Christians. The service begins at 7:00 p.m. A reception will follow in the Fellowship Hall.

Roman Catholic priests are extending this same invitation to their parishioners. Those who want to sing in a combined choir for the event should arrive at 6:00 p.m. to rehearse.

And, although there are things to celebrate about our Lutheran heritage, "celebration" isn't the right word for this anniversary. We do well to remember that the past 500 years have not only been years of reformation of the church, but of division and conflict within the church, separating us from our Catholic sisters and brothers, as well as other expressions of Christian faith

Only in the last 50 years have we been able to have unprecedented conversations with Roman Catholics, leading to a surprising amount of agreement on what we believe. Last August, the Churchwide Assembly of the ELCA, met in New Orleans and approved several recent statements of agreement between Lutherans and Catholics.

Looking ahead, a commemoration in 2017 will be held at St. Louis Cathedral on Monday, Oct 23rd, with the bishop of our Gulf Coast Synod, ELCA, Bishop Michael Rinehart, and Catholic Archbishop Aymond presiding.
