Rob Bell, a Christian author, pastor and television personality has written a new book called, *What Is The Bible*. In about 200 pages, Bell starts from the beginning, that the book we call the Bible is a collection of other books, 66 of them in fact. Arranged in a particular way, by real live people, living in real places that shares with us God's living Word for living out a life of faith. If I didn't know better I would think Bell must be a Lutheran.

*What Is The Bible*, will be a book I will use in a program at some point in our congregation. Bell uses humor, contemporary examples and easy to read language to move the reader from a very basic understanding of scripture to a fairly deep understanding of a progressive Gospel of love and forgiveness and a personal relationship with Jesus, our Savior.

It would make a great gift for your friends or children who are skeptical about organized religion or fearful of the way some church uses the words of scripture to hurt or marginalize groups of people. If you do read it, please let me know what you think about it. I would be very interested.

I will regularly share with you, in this newsletter article the things that I am reading. Sometimes I will be recommending them and certainly there will be times I will guide you away from others. Either way I am hopeful that this article and our shared reading will lead to a deeper conversation about faith and life.
