HERE'S AN UPDATE FOR YOU ON... THE MWANA MISSION **PROJECT IN MALAWI, AFRICA!**

During the month of September and part of October I went to Malawi to inspect programs in place and set the groundwork for the NEW programs for our future team(s) in 2017.



Proudly we report that the maize crop on our land was not only able to feed orphaned children and our geriatric community, but literally hundreds starving. that are The despair is

beyond shocking. Not only were we able to assist, but we have 40 55kg (120lbs) bags in *the container*. These sell for about \$70.00 per bag. This means that the Mwana Mission Project is self-reliant for existing . programs and future needs.

Another way for self-sustainability is we have two shops now between our property and the Clinic which is helping the village and community. The Shop name is "Good Tidings".

The smaller of the two **GOOD TIDINGS** (10 x 12) is vegetables and fruit that are grown on our property



and in the village. The larger one (14 x 14) was designed by what the people wanted, to avoid walking into town.

Ufa (ground maize), salt, sugar, tea, spices, fabric and sewing notions, nails and hardware, locks, keys, doorknobs, cement and over the counter medicine. Thanks to donated things from Hosanna and our Mandeville community stored in *the container*, we have towels, blankets, cloth diapers and underwear available for sale. Praise God!

With the cyclone and floods of 2015 and the severe drought of 2016 these are desperate times and we just can't do this alone. Our Albino group is growing and we have been able to reach out in the community and the entire country, which is a massive endeavor! We need the Community Center now We have more than ever. established boys and girls clubs, and are known for our love and Godly example.
