Dear members of Hosanna Lutheran Church,

It has been my pleasure to serve you as your Interim Senior Pastor over the past 21 months. When I was asked to go to Mandeville, I said yes not even sure where I was going, with no idea how to catch beads or eat a crawfish. I've got new skills now. It's been a blessing to learn new things with you - good months for me, and I hope, for you.

We can celebrate that time together in worship Sunday, May 7. And then I'll be with you one more Sunday, May 14, when we will celebrate with the young people affirming their faith on Confirmation Sunday. Two days later, May 16, will be my last day at Hosanna.

And then I am excited to turn the role of pastor over to your new pastor, Jay Grave. You've made a good choice, and I believe he will serve you faithfully and well. Welcome him into your lives and into your community of faith with open arms. Go to him for counsel and spiritual direction. Seek his leadership in defining your mission, programs, and ministry together. Celebrate together at your baptisms and weddings, call on him at times of illness and need, and hold to the hope of the resurrection together at your losses and funerals.

While I hold you in my heart, I, like every previous pastor who has served you, will no longer be available for such pastoral acts. It is important for you to have the space and the time to build a new relationship together as pastor and congregation. I generally make a point of having no contact with a previous congregation for at least a year (that would sort of be like trying to explain to your new spouse why you keep seeing your old girlfriend).

Sooner or later in the church, our paths will cross again, but until then you are always in my prayers. I'll always be interested in what is happening with you, where God is leading you, what changes and challenges and opportunities for growth and grace this life of faith affords you.

May you be filled with the knowledge of God's will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding, so that you may lead lives worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to him, as you bear fruit in every good work and as you grow in the knowledge of God. (Colossians 1:9-10)
