In the stormy days of the reformation, which began exactly 500 years ago this month, Martin Luther, a Roman Catholic Monk in a sleepy German town, set into motion ideas that would change the world. These ideas, when accompanied by the latest technology (the printing press, the discovery of the New World, great advances in banking and medicine) altered the known world. As the reformation took hold and the church began to change Luther wrote that the church should *Semper Reformanda!*

Semper Reformanda means that the church should always be changing, re-forming and re-imagining how Christians live the church into being in new ways each and every year. We know something about that here, don't we. New Pastor, new office staff, new programs and new opportunities. We have talked about firm foundations and new beginnings and as our reformation emphasis month gets under way we will spend more time talking about our Lutheran heritage as building blocks into our re-formed future.

In the five weeks of October we will examine themes of Luther's reformation. Starting October one we watched a short video from our confirmation ministry and then I preached on five themes, Luther, *Adiaphora* (a Greek word that is pretty important), Justification, and The Cross. On October 29 we will celebrate our heritage in a celebration Reformation service (wear Red).

During this Lutheran Heritage anniversary month, there are a few special activities, I am excited to offer.

October started with Blessing of the Pets, it was a great way to invite our neighbors and coworkers to see what we are up to at Hosanna. Every pet received a personal blessing and a small leash medallion to serve as a milestone of this event. Thank you for bringing your four-legged and furry friends to celebrate the blessedness of God's creation and the lives we share together.

On October 23, a Monday night, our Texas-Louisiana Gulf Coast Synod Bishop, Mike Rinehart will be part of a joint Lutheran/Catholic commemoration worship at the St. Louis Cathedral in New Orleans. I would love to overwhelm the crowd with a bunch of Hosanna folks. We will meet at Jackson Square at 6:40pm so that we can sit near each other. This should be a very beautiful worship experience.

On Sunday night October 29, we will watch the feature film, *Luther the Reformer*. This movie was released a few years ago. This event is for all and will include many of our Youth Night students. You are welcome to join us for supper (chicken pot pie, I believe) beginning at 5:30 PM. The movie will start at 6:00pm. Popcorn will be provided, because even a movie like *Luther* is better with popcorn.

We are always reforming and reshaping. We as a congregation are always striving to better share the Gospel with the world around us. Blessed Re-forming.



From Conflict to Communion Lutheran-Catholic Commemoration of the Reformation


