

Grace to you and Peace,

May is a busy month. Quilt blessings and concerts, Mother's Day, Confirmation, Graduations and a host of other pre-summer activities are upon us. Our lives our filled with celebrations and occasions to be with other people. Standing around grills or boiling pots or coolers, we have a great opportunity to share our faith. "WHOA, Hold on there, Pastor!" you might be saying. Evangelism is sometimes a scary world and we live in a society with an expectation that we keep faith, sex, and finance advice to ourselves... except that we don't.

Hosanna has a fantastic mission statement. Each Sunday at the end of the service, I ask "Hosanna, what is your mission?" and you respond that we "proclaim the love of God to all people, so that they may know Jesus Christ, grow in faith, and follow Christ." You may have heard me say that this is one of the most evangelical mission statements I have ever heard. It is all about the *other*. The mission statement is not about us. It isn't about our faith development. It isn't about our own discipleship, our mission is about sharing God's love with someone else. The most effective way to do that is, hang on, it is pretty wild, is by telling your story.

How has Jesus changed your life. How has being a part of this congregation helped you in times of trouble? How has knowledge of salvation altered your perspective of the world around you? How has weekly attendance at worship bolstered your work life? Share with your friends and family why it is so important to go to small group. Share with them why it is necessary for you to set you alarm early on Sunday mornings, or why you will come to the festival a little later, after worship. Why is it important to get back for this meeting or that. Friends, that is our mission: to PROCLAIM.

In May, the elected church council will be having a retreat to study our strategic plan. A plan that puts feet on our mission statement. A plan that beings to flesh out our method for proclaiming to all people. This plan involves some new staff, a new worship service that begins in June, additional small groups, fellowship events and of course, EVANGELISM. I will be sharing this plan with the congregation as well. We will be planning opportunities to practice our evangelism skills. We will be scheduling opportunities to invite our neighbors and friends to hear

about Jesus at Hosanna. We will be growing as we proclaim, and that is of course, the point.

Until then, brothers and sisters, proclaim the good news of Jesus in any way you see fit. Share of God's love to all around you! Tell of His Glory and be the church.


