



Hosanna Lutheran Church Council Meeting October 21, 2019

The regular meeting of the Hosanna Lutheran Church Council was called to order at 7:10 p.m. on October 21, 2019 in Fellowship Hall by Brad Phillips. Pastor Jay opened with prayer.

Present: Pastor Jay Grave, Rob Rhea, Brad Phillips, Steve Beene, Ryan Weber, Teresa Abrams, Julie Brown and George Michell. A quorum was established.

1. Open Discussion

Is our (church and council) focused or off target?

- a. Julie feels as if we are doing better and moving forward. A suggestion was to send emails to small group leaders to promote events.
- b. George feels as if he is behind on what he where planning to be at this time.
- c. Steve feels as if the new council members needs some experience and thinks that should come within 6 months
- d. Rob feels as if it is not moving as fast as it should
- e. Teresa feels as if the youth movement could be better. Need more parent involvement. Need more volunteers for the youth areas.
- f. Pastor Jay thinks the church is not large enough or moving in that direction enough to increase staff as we had hoped to do.
- g. Brad wants us to come to church next Sunday and look at it as if it was our first time there. From parking, greeting, seating, service and leaving. Let the council know your thoughts.
- h. In rebranding the church, Steve came up with the idea of putting a cross out front with a light. He will mark the spot he thinks would be best. We will have to purchase a permit from the Parish to put it in a place that would be most beneficial.

2. President's Report

- a. As Council members, are we working on getting the metrics for our ministries?
 - i. Some have ability to retrieve this data.
 - ii. Grace can provide the direction for those that need assistance.
- b. Be sure to update the Church To-Do Spreadsheet.
- c. Communication: This is an ongoing issue and Steve brought up, rather than emailing, a call or face to face, will produce better results in obtaining volunteers. How to get people to attend events? Sell tickets; this would require people to at least commit. Discontinue events that are not getting enough people.

3. Pastor's Report:

- a. The AA Meeting had 60+ attendees. Some brought their kids and they saw other kids that they knew. This could provide additional worshipers.
- b. Moving right along with the operating system binders. Fun Church Fun, and Concealed Carry Policy are just a couple that are completed. If you have any procedures completed, you can give them to the staff.
- c. George and Pastor Jay are getting a committee together to start looking for a Worship Leader. Brad said not to put binders on and just look to replace Brian but to see what we could do to make this position a more encompassing position.
- d. We will be using a professional Custodial Firm to replace our current custodian. Today was his last day. The cost will be about the same.
- e. Hot Meals was discussed, and it looks as if we will be able to feed 50 people a week. There will be a grant of \$250, a month and Hosanna will provide \$250 a month. We will need another \$250 in donations. Everyone thinks this is a great ministry. Steve will provide the dishes.
- f. In rebranding the church, Steve came up with the idea of putting a cross out front with a light. He will mark the spot he thinks would be best. We will have to purchase a permit from the Parish to put it in a place that would be most beneficial.

Church Council Meeting cont.

- g. Teresa is writing up procedures for the Nursery. Got a lot of push back, but all was good in the end.
- h. On the last day of VBS a 10 or 11-year-old boy broke his arm as he got out of the Gaga Ball Pit. He was taken to hospital by ambulance. His sister complained about her arm, but it did not appear to be bad. Later her parents informed the church that it was broken as well. She said it started hurting when she hit the ball. The parents asked for our insurance company information. These are not church members.

4. Financial Report:

IRS Payroll Tax Issue:

- I. There will be a meeting on November 3rd with current Exec Council plus past presidents and treasurers. This will be to inform the previous council members what is being done and to let them know they have nothing to be concerned about.
- II. The Budget meeting will be held for the congregation on November 11th. The IRS issue will be explained at that time. A letter will go out after that so anyone not attending will be informed. There will be a budget meeting after the 2nd service on October 27th.

 III. Rob made a motion to write the check and George 2nd. Vote was unanimous. The check is \$38432.76 Plus or
- minus any findings since.
- IV. Brad will send the budget to the council tonight.

5. Approval of Minutes

Rob Rhea motioned for previous meeting minutes be approved. Steve Beene seconded. All were in favor.

Rob suggested we get Entergy to review our facility to help us reduce the electric bill. It was noted that the new electrical in the sanctuary will also reduce the bill.

Adjournment

Meeting was adjourned at 9:06 p.m. by Brad Phillips. Steve Beene motioned to adjourn meeting, and Rob Rhea seconded. All were in favor. Pastor Jay closed with prayer.
