When I was interviewing for a pastor position several years ago, my reference told a member of the call committee that I was the kind of pastor who would, "take a drunk off the street and before you knew it, he would be on the church council." The reference meant it as a negative, but I have never heard a better compliment in my life. That church did call me to be their pastor and before they knew it, we had recovering addicts singing in the choir, we had adult baptisms and confirmation classes, we were welcoming new members and even having a wine and cheese reception after our Saturday night services.

I left that congregation to come to Hosanna. "Proclaiming the Love of God to All People" seemed right up my alley. A history of having "all God's creatures" having a place in the choir sounded pretty cool, and of course an ELCA congregation organized around the framework of the Purpose Driven Church. I was in! My challenge as pastoral leader in this congregation is how to bring all these principles together into a vision we can live into together.

Hard conversations in 2019 brought about new Bible studies and discussion groups. Discussion groups led to growing outreach ministries and new ways to see traditional programming. Seeing programming in new ways led to changes in staffing and even with all of this change my perception is still the same.

How does Hosanna Lutheran Church Proclaim the Love of God to All People, so they may Know Jesus Christ, Grow in Faith, and Follow Christ?

It is simple. We continue Being the Church Together. Our Lutheran heritage teaches us that welcoming all is at the core of the Gospel message. We are reminded that we are all sinners in need of God's saving grace which is given as a gift. We are each convicted by the law and set free by the Gospel and because of that we each have a unique story of redemption to share. Together we will spend more time with Luther as part of our Spiritual Growth Campaign.

As we continue to be church together, we continue to make space for all of God's creatures to have a place in the choir. Literally, as in the Interim Worship Team which continues to meet Thursday nights to sing, laugh, and learn the songs for the following Sunday worship. If you like to sing, come and join in the fun. We all knew building a new worship team would be a difficult process. We have had some applicants and put a couple plans together, but as the writer of Proverbs says, **"Many are the plans in the mind of Man, but the purpose of the Lord will prevail."** We continue to pray that God will lead us in the search process.

If the worship team isn't for you, maybe you want to lead a new small group. Elizabeth is training new leaders all the time; helping new groups get started. Maybe you want to help with worship, or volunteer in the office, help with our Sunday night youth program. Maybe, God is calling you to participate in a completely new way. That is awesome! Let's talk and get you plugged into ministry. All are welcome!

As we continue being Church together, we will also learn from the earliest Christian church. This month I will be preaching from the book of Acts. This 5th book in our New Testament is part historical and part motivational. Luke, the writer of Acts chronicles the early days of the first Christian church. What they did on a daily basis. How the incorporated new people. How they dealt with controversy. How they changed with the power of the Spirit.


