

COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
DATE: DECEMBER 6, 2021

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 5:35 pm by Rob Rhea.

Members Present: Rob Rhea, Marc Reed, Steve Beene, Nathan Hoffman, Charles Stone, Rachael Moore, George Michell, Pastor Jerry Mansholt.

Members Absent: Doug Burbank.

Property Sale Status: The Field Church came in for inspections 12/2/2021. They made an inquiry about the purchase of the piano. They were informed a charge of \$18,500.00 would be required. Hosanna will retain all building contents and the stained glass behind the altar. They have asked Hosanna to finance 10% of the selling price (\$230,000.00) which Hosanna is prepared to do. Hosanna will not make any repairs to the building prior to the sale.

It was disclosed that possible repairs would include \$45,000 for AC repair, \$20,000 for septic system repair, \$100,000-150,000 for roof repairs. Field Church indicated they understood and plan to accept as is.

We still have 2 active back up sales still interested in the property, i.e. the theatre and the developer.

Redevelopment: The Council needs to vote on Re-development versus Traditional Call Process in order to make a recommendation to the congregation for Sunday, 12/12/2021 Special Congregational Meeting.

Pastor Chris Markert spoke to the congregation following the 9:30 AM service yesterday. He described the Re-development process and answered many questions posed by congregational members regarding Re-Development, calling a re-development pastor, and calling a pastor via the traditional route. The council believes that the advantages of entering re-development would include: The pastor reports to the district synod (Pastor Markert), a new pastor could be in place in 2-3 months, 4 members will continue to serve on the Executive Council to monitor church operations, re-development has the potential to be a great opportunity for Hosanna, and Hosanna would be able to benefit from the synodical resources and training.

It was mentioned that the church will need to continue to operate on deficit spending until membership can be increased and our facilities are "right-sized".

Motion made by Steve that council should make a recommendation to the congregation to proceed with re-development process. George seconded. No further discussion needed. Council unanimously voted to recommend re-development to the congregation at the meeting on Sunday 12/12/21.

Adjournment: With no other business, it was moved and seconded, and the meeting was adjourned at 6:18 PM.


