But Jesus said to them, "Take heart, it is I; do not be afraid."

Peter answered him, "Lord, if it is you, command me to come to you on the water." Jesus said, "Come." (paraphrase of Matthew 14:22-29)

This story is part of our series "Wandering Heart: finding out faith with Peter".

In our conference room, is a carved olive wood figurine I purchased this past summer while I was in the Holy Land. The figurine depicts Jesus pulling Peter out of the water when he takes his eyes off Jesus and begins to sink. It reminds me of two things:

- 1. If we want to walk on water, we must get out of the boat. If we think of this personally then you can probably imagine a time when you took a risk (i.e. got out of the boat) not knowing what will happen. I invite you to also think of this in terms of the church. Hosanna Lutheran Church has also "gotten out of the boat." Taken risks, stepped out in faith trusting God's call for us going forward.
- 2. When we begin to sink—and we will—Jesus meets us, brings us out of the water and into safety, but then expects us to get back out of the boat to continue the work. Jesus also promises never to leave us alone. He continually puts people in our lives to help us and guide us.
