Hello Everyone!

From Psalm 100: A Psalm of thanksgiving.

1Make a joyful noise to the LORD, all the earth. 2Worship the LORD with gladness; come into his presence with singing. 3Know that the LORD is God. It is he that made us, and we are his; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture. 4Enter his gates with thanksgiving, and his courts with praise. Give thanks to him, bless his name. 5For the LORD is good; his steadfast love endures forever, and his faithfulness to all generations.

November is a time of thanksgiving. It's a time to give thanks and remember all that God has given us.

I have a friend who, during the pandemic, began a daily Facebook post of three things that she's thankful for. I enjoy reading her posts everyday because it reminds me of all the things I am thankful for. Her posts that I like the most are the ones in which she gives thanks for things like "the one tomato that grew from the vine," or "a free afternoon;" even her day when she is grateful for "a day where I accomplished nothing."

My friends, on Sunday, November 3, we begin our month of thankfulness with observance of All Saints Day. On that day, we light a candle in remembrance of those we love whom we lost in the last year. We also light a candle and give thanks for those that we have welcomed into the community through the waters of Baptism. And then we light a candle anyone else we remember on that day. All in all, it's meant to be a day of thanksgiving, for the joy people bring into our lives, and the fulfillment of God's promises made to us in our baptism. I hope you can come be with us on that day during our worship service. If you are unable to attend, you are certainly welcome to participate with us virtually through our Facebook page.

We also have a budget meeting on that day following worship. During that meeting we will be talking about the vision of Hosanna moving forward. It's an important meeting and everyone, whether a "member" or not, is encouraged to attend.

And one other thing: Tuesday November 5th is (finally!) election day in this country. I'm going to offer a prayer for you to pray on this day. It's attributed to St Francis of Assisi:

Lord, make us instruments of your peace. Where there is hatred, let us sow love; where there is injury, pardon; where there is discord, union; where there is doubt, faith; where there is despair, hope; where there is darkness, light; where there is sadness, joy. Grant that we may not so much seek to be consoled as to console; to be understood as to understand; to be loved as to love. For it is in giving that we receive; it is in pardoning that we are pardoned; and it is in dying that we are born to eternal life. Amen

Please remember that the people you gather with for Thanksgiving and all the holidays are the same people now that they were before the election. God wants us to love one another. What binds us together is stronger than what separates us. That "something" is God, in whose image we are all created.


I'm thankful for you; for your tireless commitment to the life and ministry of Hosanna Lutheran Church, and more importantly, to the community in which we are called to serve.




