Hello everyone! Happy New Year!

During the Advent season we used the theme, "Words for the beginning". It was and is an appropriate theme for Hosanna because on December 15th we voted to exit the redevelopment process and begin the "implementation" phase. What does that mean? It means that we have been listening to the Holy Spirit and we feel like we understand better the direction in which the Spirit is calling us.

You've heard me say this before but one of Hosanna's greatest gifts is the gift of being generous, and at the same time being very outwardly focused. These two gifts embody what Jesus calls the church to be. It's what he embodied in his earthly ministry.

To that end, we have discerned that our call has the body of Christ in this community is to, as one of our members has said, to double down on what we're good at. In the coming months we're going to roll out this plan.

When Hosanna entered the redevelopment process, we created a covenant (a promise) that spelled out the specific roles of the synod, the redevelopment pastor, the redevelopment team, the executive team, and the congregation. We will create a similar covenant for our implementation phase.

The difference in these two covenants will be that, while during redevelopment the focus was on the redevelopment team and the redevelopment pastor, during the implementation phase, the focus will be on you: Hosanna members and regular attendees. Together, we will develop procedures for grants, and you will help by identifying organizations in this community that are doing good work and would benefit from our generosity.

But this isn't just about giving away money; this is about outreach. And it's about investing in our community. It's also very much about sharing the stories not of the work that we're doing but of the work that God is doing through us.

I'm excited about this new direction, and the commitment that you have to Hosanna Lutheran Church and spreading the gospel. It happens almost every day in the work that you do in your families, and your workplace, and your schools, and in the community. I'm excited that we get to do this work alongside our sisters and brothers in Christ at Covington Presbyterian Church and other local churches.

It's a great time to be the Church here at Hosanna and I invite you to tell the story of what we're about and to invite others to be part of this new ministry. God is doing great things here and I'm excited to walk with you along this path. 2025 is going to be a great year!
