Did you know? The date of Easter is determined by the first Sunday on or after the first full moon on or after the vernal equinox. That means that Easter will never be earlier than March 22, nor later than April 25. Back up 40-days (not counting Sundays) and you get Ash Wednesday. Just a little science information for you. You're welcome!

How ever it's determined astrologically or chronologically, we know that Jesus died and rose from the dead and we celebrate that event every year. And even more important than specific dates, we get to celebrate all year long what Jesus has done for us.

And we also take time to remember what it cost God and our own culpability in it. If Jesus' death and resurrection was just a one-time event, then we could blame those present at the time exclusively and we would not need to be accountable.

St Paul writes, "Therefore we have been buried with him by baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, so we too might walk in newness of life. For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we will certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his." (Romans 6:4-5)

We are resurrection people: we can both lament our own sin, and celebrate the promise of the resurrection, not only after-death, but also right here, right now.

We will be rotating Holy Week services again this year. Maundy Thursday (April 15) worship will be at First United Methodist Church (203 N. Jefferson Ave, Covington). Our Good Friday (April 16) service will be here at Hosanna. All services start at 6pm and everyone is welcome.

Join us again on Easter Sunday, April 20, as we (again) remember and celebrate the Resurrection of our Lord, at 9am.

So, even though this is still Lent, we can boldly and confidently say, "Christ is risen! He is risen indeed!"


