"What does the synod do?"

I was recently asked this I wasn't prepared to answer that question, and that led me to some guilt(?) because I couldn't answer with a "3-minute elevator speech". I should know the answer to that right off the top of my head. But I didn't.

This has prompted me to reflect. Not because the synod fails to offer value, but perhaps pastorcandis@gmail.com because I have underestimated the contributions of the synod as an extension of the church. 276-243-7711 As a rostered leader in the ELCA and the TX/LA Gulf Coast Synod, if I am unable to clearly communicate the role and importance of the synod, it is unreasonable to expect congregational members to understand their functions and impact.

So, I wanted to take a moment this month to share my recollection. It was a good exercise for me. I hope it will be informative, and maybe even helpful, for you. First, a little context:

The TX/LA Gulf Coast Synod includes 106 congregations from Peace Lutheran in Slidell, LA to St Paul Lutheran in La Grange, TX, divided into seven conferences. Hosanna is part of the Bayou Conference, ranging from Peace in Slidell to St Paul in Lake Charles. As the Dean of the Bayou Conference, I act as the Bishop's representative for pastoral installations and local ecumenical partnerships.

The Bishop is responsible for providing leadership and support to the congregations. That takes many forms (not an all-inclusive list):

- \cdot developing and recruiting ministry leaders (Deacons, Pastors, and Lay Leaders),
- \cdot developing new ministries and redevelopment of congregations as necessary,
- · ecumenical partnerships,
- \cdot disaster preparation and response,
- engaging with other service organizations to provide resources for congregations (e.g. LEAD).
- · Campus Ministries, Camping Ministries

There was a follow up observation which I also appreciated: "Well, it feels like the "synod" is very Texas-centric." The truth is, there is some truth to that, primarily because that's where the synod office is located. My experience is that this is more about geography than about care. Because of our location vis-à-vis the Synod Office, we in the Bayou Conference have become adept at handling our own needs. (i.e. we've become more independent). That is both good and bad.

There's lots more to say about this, but as I said, I wanted to keep this to a 3-minute (ish) elevator speech!

Continue to ask questions and challenge. That's how we grow!


